KARATE EVENT UNDER MOROCCAN DOMINATION

Close of the karate event of the All-Africa Games' 12th edition held at Prince Moulay Abdallah complex sports Hall. At the end of the 10th day of competitions, Morocco comes at the leading position of the final ranking with 12 medals, including 9 gold, 4 silver and two bronze. played.

The gold medals were won by Moroccan champions Sayah Aicha in the -50kg category, Nisrin Brouk (-68kg), Sanae Agalmam (individual Kata), as well as by the champions Ashraf Ouchene (+84kg),

Abderrahmane Eddaqaq (-67kg) and Mohamed El Hanni (individual Kata). The Moroccan men's and women's teams won the team kata competition, while the women's team won the team kumite. Abdesalam Ameknassi (-60 kg), Khaoula Ouhmad (-55kg), Nabil Chaabi (-84kg), as well as the national team in the men's kumite event offered Morocco four silver medals. For their part, Ibtissam Sadini (-61kg) and Yassine Sekouri (-75kg) added two bronze medals to this outstanding Moroccan performance.









OVERALL RANKING: EGYPT BREAKS THE 100 MEDALS BARRIER!

In third place since the last two days, Morocco manages to consolidate its ranking. The host country, which has won on Monday its 56th medal (15 gold, 16 silver, 25 bronze), is ahead of its rival with a difference of two gold and two silver medals. At the end of the 10th day of competition, Algeria has grabbed 55

medals including 13 gold, 14 silver and 28 bronze. Meanwhile, at the top of the podium, Egypt crossed the barrier of one hundred medals with a total of 102 medals (34 gold, 43 silver, 25 bronze). South Africa, actually, remains far behind, but still in second place, with 56 medals (25 gold, 17 silver, 14 bronze).
