## 1. HISTORY OF THE AFRICAN GAMES :

Organized for the first time in 1965 in Brazzaville, the African Games will celebrate in Rabat, capital of the Kingdom of Morocco, from August 19th to 31st, 2019, its twelfth edition and the first one, after 50 years of existence. It will be an opportunity for Africa to outline proudly a multi-sport competition's achievements and highlights, which the Kingdom of Morocco, in

collaboration with African sports governing bodies, aims today to promote to the rank of an international notorious event.

The African Games "All Games Africa", recognized since their launching by the International Olympic Committee (IOC), were celebrated eleven times in nine African different cities.

## 2. THE GAMES' GOALS

### The African Games' goals are:

- › To encourage young athletes to develop improve themselves and reach levels that which make them apt to represent their nations;
- › To give the opportunity to young people from different Member States to meet, get to know each other, in order to develop the Community spirit that is essential for the regional integration fulfilment;
- › To develop a spirit of fair play, mutual respect and Olympism among young athletes originating from the continent;
- › To give the opportunity to African countries to unite through working on a defined sports program of common agreement;
- › The African Games are a multidisciplinary sports competition aiming to promote high-level African sport and encourage cultural exchange between African Union (AU) member states that have a National Olympic Committee.

### 2.1. XIITH AFRICAN GAMES, RABAT 2019

The African Games, also called the "All Africa Games", are a multi-sport competition held on a four years basis on the African continent.

Pierre de Coubertin, founder of the Olympic Games, had proposed that idea which unfortunately has been neglected until the

1960s independence movements. Taking over from the Friendship Games that involved the French-speaking countries, the first Games were organized in Brazzaville in 1965 and immediately recognized by the International Olympic Committee.

The 12th edition of the African Games, placed under the High Patronage of His Majesty King Mohammed VI, will be held in Rabat from August 19th to 31st 2019, according to the agreement protocol signed in Rabat on November 10th, 2018 conferring on the Kingdom the honour to organise these Games.

### 2.2. CLIMATE

The Atlantic coast enjoys a soft climate, similar to that of the Mediterranean, but even softer.

Winters look like intermediate seasons, and have long sunny periods, and summers are pleasantly warm and sunny. The rains are not that abundant, however, from November to March they can sometimes be intense and concentrated in time.



### 2.3. WEATHER IN RABAT, CASABLANCA AND EL-JADIDA

Located on the edge of the Atlantic Ocean, they have a temperate climate. The winter is mild and the rainfall is generally frequent. Summer is pleasantly warm.

Average temperatures range from 13 ° C in January to 23 ° C in July and August. Some

coastal cities experience heat waves, which, however, are less intense and much rarer than in hinterland.

Rabat-Salé Airport, (IATA code: RBA • ICAO code: GMME) is a Moroccan international airport located in the district of Salé and 8 km north-east of Rabat, in the Rabat-Salé-Kenitra region.

In 2018, the airport registered approximately one million passengers, with a total of 987,485 passengers.

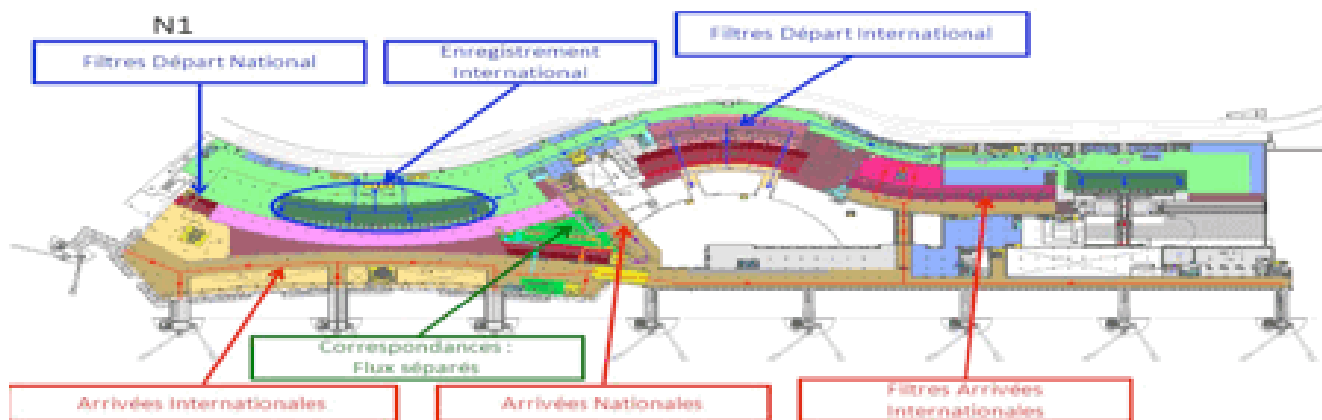

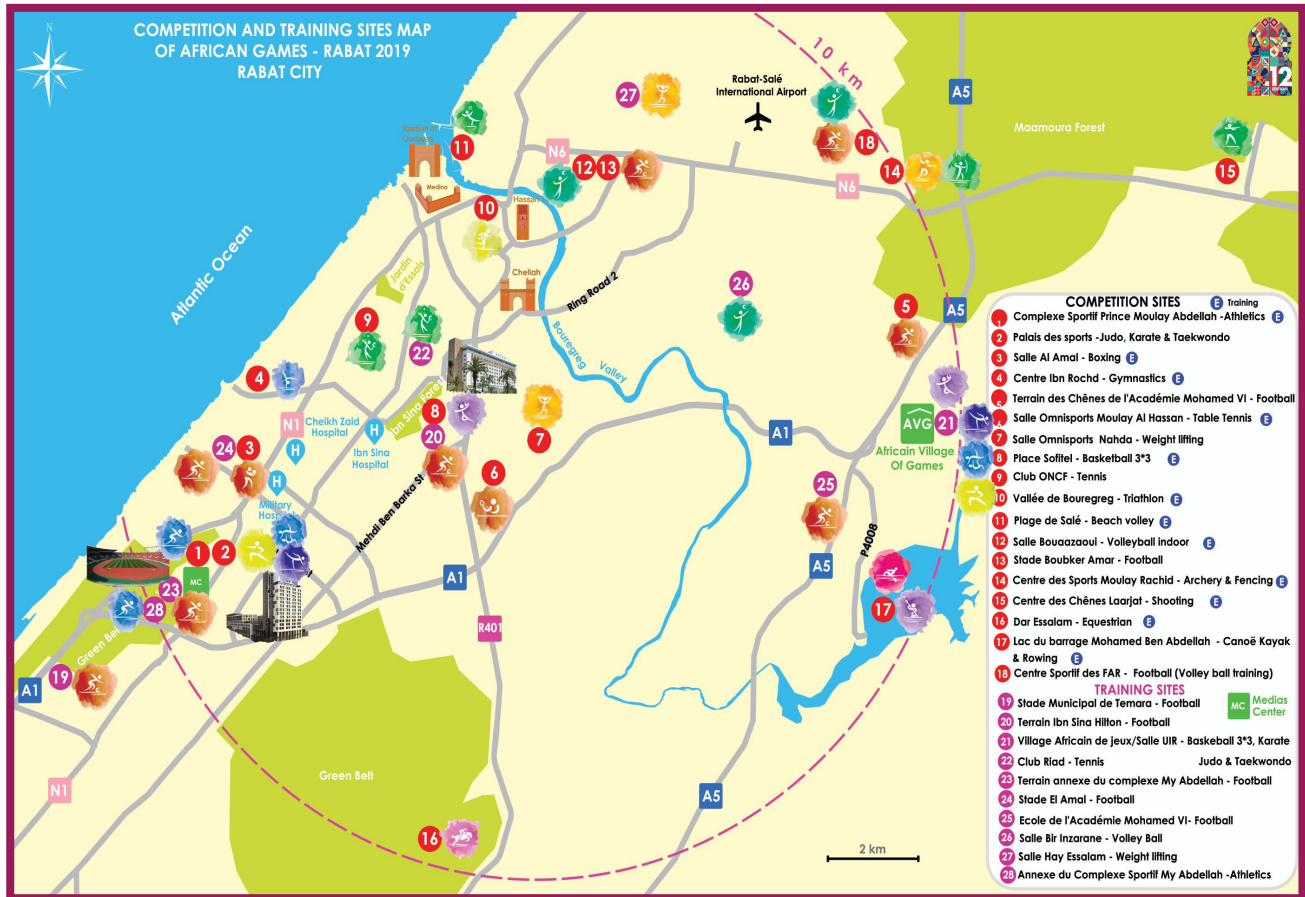

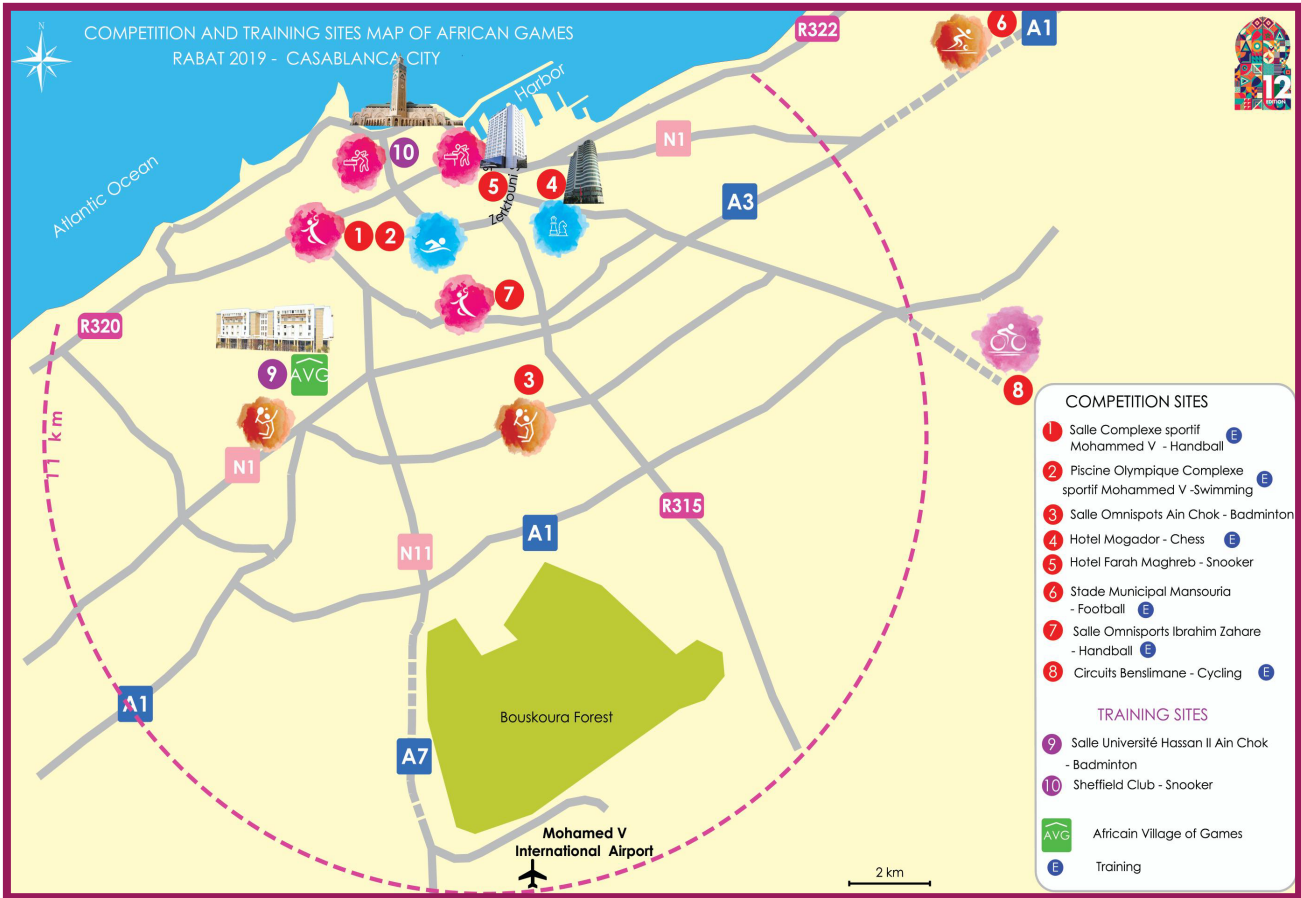

## 1. TRANSPORTATION STRATEGY

The 2019 Rabat African Games' transport strategy (RAG) will be based on best practices in transport planning. All African family members will be able to move around quickly and safely to all competition venues and training sites and other areas, using highways and the large network of roads for multi-passenger vehicles and toll lanes, while traveling to other host cities. The journey duration (in the same city) to and from most competition venues and training sites will not exceed 30 minutes.

RAG's transport strategy aims to enable athletes, officials, media and the entire African family to travel safely, comfortably while respecting the competition's schedules by using the Games' network.

## 2. AIRPORTS

The main international Airport for the 2019 Rabat African Games will be: Mohammed V Casablanca International Airport, Route of Nouasseur, Casablanca, with an attendance of 2,226,981 passengers, and Rabat-Salé International Airport, located in Salé, 8 km north-east of Rabat, with 266,183 passengers, chosen as the second airport dedicated to the Games.

## 3. MAIN DESTINATIONS FROM AIRPORTS

## 3.2. ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE TRANSPORT PLAN FROM AIRPORTS (TRANSFERS)

### 3.2.1. TRANSPORT OF PARTICIPATING DELEGATIONS

#### › Arrivals

Plan is operational for delegations as of the official opening of the African Games Village (August 13rd, 2019).

Rabat African Games' Organizing Committee (RAGOC) organizes the transfer of the delegations arriving at Casablanca and Rabat airports, to the accreditation centres and their accommodation venues.

Transportation between airports and accreditation and accommodation locations will be performed by coach.

To benefit from this service, the Heads of Mission will have to communicate, at the latest (date to be communicated later), the arrival and departure form (individual or collective for groups).

This form will contain the following data, which must be completed in full: place and time of arrival/departure, provenance/destination, flight numbers, number of accredited persons to be transported, large baggage needing

specific transport, any other information and particularities to report.

#### › Departures

Plan is operational until the closing of the African Village (September 3, 2019).

During the departure operation, the accredited persons will be transported from their places of accommodation to the places of departure according to the information previously communicated to RAGOC, through a Departure confirmation form (individual or group) to be completed and delivered to the transportation office at the African Games Village, 24 hours before the departure time.

In case of any changes in dates/times in relation to the Arrival and Departure Form already communicated to RAGOC, the departure confirmation form must be sent 72 hours before the departure time.

All travellers heading to the airport will be transported in order to arrive at least 90 minutes before the departure time of their flight if the departure is from RABAT airport, and 120 minutes in the case of departures from Casablanca Airport.



In all cases, appropriate measures to facilitate the registration of passengers and their baggage will be undertaken by mutual agreement with airport operators (ONDA) to ensure the smooth flow of boarding operations.

### 3.2.2. MEDIA TRANSPORT

#### › Arrivals

Plan is available from August 13th, 2019.

The RAGOC organizes the transfer of Media arriving at RABAT or CASABLANCA airports to the accreditation center and their accommodation.

Transportation from the point of arrival to the place of accreditation and accommodation will be provided by RAGOC based on the reservations previously made according to the same indications that appear for the Delegations in point 2-1.

#### › Departures

Plan is available until September 1st, 2019.

Transportation from accommodation to departure points will be provided by RAGOC based on previous bookings made according to the same instructions for delegations in point 2-1.

### 3.2.3. BAGGAGE TRANSPORT

For any baggage accompanying accredited persons, the size will determine the transport system during the arrival/departure operation.

The transfer of luggage to the accommodation will be handled by RAGOC, which will whenever possible, use the transport provided for people (baggage hold). However, if the capacity is to be insufficient (because of the size of the equipment, for example: poles, bicycles, medical staff equipment...), an additional transport will be provided in order to convey the luggage towards the places of accommodation.

In all cases, luggage must be properly labelled from the country of origin. Travelers are advised to consult the airline company prior to departure for sports equipment and large luggage.

Travelers will be responsible for dropping off and pick up their luggage and will be responsible upon arrival at the accommodation.



### 3.3. OPENING AND CLOSING CEREMONY PLAN

Specific transport operations will be deployed to ensure a fast, smooth, safe and comfortable movement of all accredited persons for the ceremonies.

Departures from accommodation places to ceremonies venues are normally scheduled from three to one hour before the start. More specific information will be provided in due course.

Transportation of all categories of participants and guests for the Opening and Closing Ceremonies will be carried out by coaches.

#### 3.3.1. THE AFRICAN FAMILY TRANSPORT

RAGOC will provide accredited persons with various means of transportation to travel during the Games, depending on the privileges on the accreditation card.

### 3.3.2. DAYS AND HOURS OF OPERATION

The transportation system of the African Games will run from August 13th to September 3rd, 2019. For the Heads of Missions arrivals prior to that date or departures after that date, special arrangements may be arranged.

The transport system of the African Games will be available during the hours of the Games workflow, from 7:00 am to 9:00 pm.

### 3.3.3. T1 AND T2 TRANSPORT SYSTEM

African Family members with T1 or T2 transport privileges can use their reserved vehicle with driver from their arrival at the airports until their departure. This mode of transport is available during the following times: from 8:00 am to 11:00 pm.

The African Family members reserved vehicles T1 and T2 can be used between all the Games sites and venues.

### 3.3.4. T3 TRANSPORT SYSTEM

Accredited persons with a T3 transport privilege will have access to the vehicle system on demand. (Taxi formula)

The T3 transport system will be available during the hours of the Games workflow (From 9:00 am to 10:00 am). On-demand vehicles for T3 privileges will strictly be used between the games sites.

### 3.3.5 T4 TRANSPORT SYSTEM

Accredited persons with a T4 transport privilege will have access to RAGOC's dedicated circuit transport on-demand.

The T4 transport system will be available during the hours of the Games workflow (from 7:00 am to 10:00 pm). On-demand vehicles for T4 privileged persons will only be used between games sites.

### 3.3.6 VEHICLES ASSIGNED TO PARTICIPATING OFFICIAL DELEGATIONS

Each participating delegation will be allocated vehicles with driver. The number of these vehicles will depend on the delegation's size (see table below). They can use at their entire convenience for their travel to the various competition and sports venues and training sites.

The vehicles assigned to each delegation will be made available after the registration of the athletes. Subsequently, each delegation will be able to make an appointment with the Transportation Office at the African Games Village to collect the assigned vehicle (s). Only the Head of Mission or his duly authorized representative will have the capacity to collect the vehicles.

The Head of Mission or his representative will have to sign a vehicle receipt sheet. The vehicles will be allocated with a comprehensive insurance.

Vehicles must be returned to the location indicated by the Transportation Office prior to the departure of the Head of Mission, along with the receipt form, to check the vehicle condition fill in a return sheet.

### 3.3.7 TA TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM

RAGOC will provide members of the official delegations with a specific transport service (coaches, minibuses) to get to the training and

competition sites and venue (regular shuttles for individual sports and transport available for Team Sports).

Heads of Mission and Deputy Head of Mission can also use this system.

Shuttle terminals will be identified with specific indication, as well as coaches dedicated to the delegations transport.

### 3.3.8 TRANSPORT OF SPECTATOR ATHLETES

Spectator athletes (individual and Team Sports) will be allowed to use shuttles operating between their accommodation places and the competition venues (according to the schedules and itineraries detailed below). However, priority will be given to athletes participating in the competition.

### 3.3.9 TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM FOR TECHNICAL OFFICIALS (TF)

The RAGOC will provide the Technical Officials with Coaches/Minibuses/Vans dedicated by discipline. The transport schedules to the competitions venues will be drafted according to the final program of the competitions.

### 3.3.10 MEDIAS TRANSPORT SYSTEM (TM)

The Media will have specific shuttles, described below, linking the hotels according to their online reservations (accommodation) to press centers (Mohamed V Sports Complex in Casablanca and Moulay Abdellah Sports Complex in Rabat) and also to the competitions and training sites. Thus, the lines M1, M2, M3, (Casablanca / Rabat) will operate during the African Games with a minibus every one hour from 8:00 am (first departure) to 10:00 pm (last departure) daily.

Dispatching will be carried out from the press centers (Casablanca / Rabat) to the competition and training venues where a sports activity will take place, according to bookings made 24 hours in advance at the transport office at the Hotels.
