AN OUTSTANDING CLOSING CEREMONY OF THE RAG

After two weeks of intense emotions, celebrations and disappointments, the curtain has come down on the 12th All Africa Games on Saturday. A great style closing ceremony was organized on the occasion. Several African singers gratified the audience with a compilation of their songs inspired from the African artistic heritage, after having played the national anthems of the three big winners of this great African sports event.

Undoubtedly, Egypt was the great leader of this edition by winning a total of 273 medals including 102 gold, 98 silver and

73 bronze. Egypt is on the top of the ranking far ahead of Nigeria with 127 medals (46 gold, 33 silver and 48 bronze), South Africa with 87 medals (including 36 gold, 26 silver and 25 bronze) and Algeria with 125 medals (including 33 gold, 32 silver and 60 bronze). Morocco, meanwhile, contented itself with the 5th place with 109 medals (31 gold, 32 silver and 46 bronze). Tunisia, Kenya, Republic of Mauritius, Ethiopia and Madagascar finish the top 10 of the final ranking of the African Games and occupy the 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th place respectively with 97, 31, 24, 23 and 12 medals.

TENNISMOROCCO AND EGYPT ON THE PODIUM

Egypt won the gold medal in the women's team tennis competition of the 12th All Africa Games, played Saturday at the Cheminots Club in Rabat. The Egyptians Salama Lamis, Ahmed Rana, Abdelsalam Sandra and Abdelaziz Maiar have won out over the Moroccan team composed of Sara Akid, Rita Atik, Rania Azziz and

Salma Ziouti. The game ended with two set to zero (3-6, 2-6, 0-6, 0-6). The same day, Morocco gets its revenge on Egypt, in the men's tennis event final and grabbed thereby its last gold medal. The team composed by Ouahab Lamine, Moundir Adam Ralph Khalifa, Kilani Yassir and Fattar Anas won with a score of 2-0.









VOLLEYBALLCAMEROON GRABS THE GOLD

Cameroon wins the gold medal of the 12th All Africa Games men's volleyball competition. After its victory against Morocco on Saturday at the Bouazzaoui Sports Hall, with a score of 3-1, the Cameroonian team achieved thus an

impressive track record at this competition. It is followed by Algeria which defeated Cape Verde 3-0. The Algerians were defeated only once against Cameroon. Egypt gets the bronze medal after losing two games.
